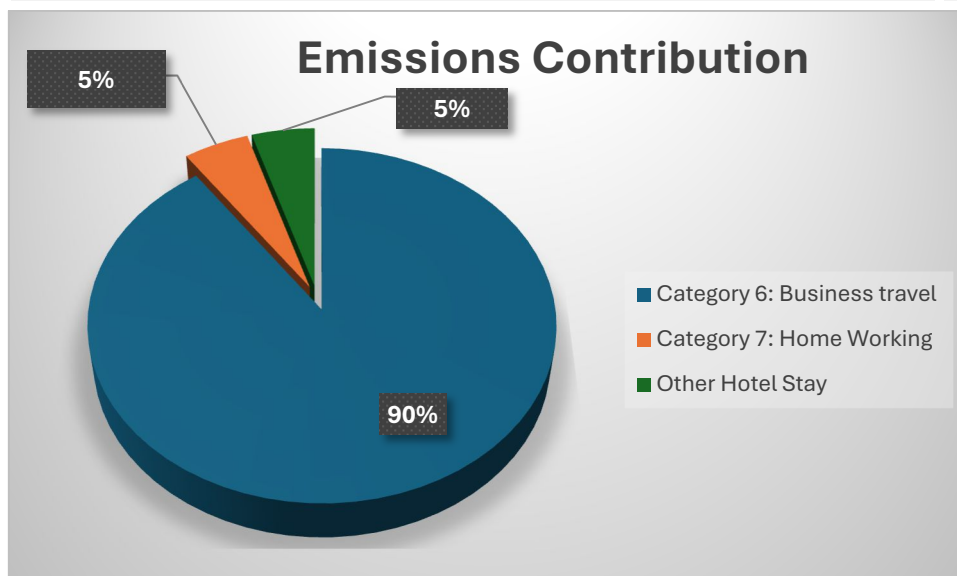
## Commitment to achieving Net Zero by 2040

### Zero Emissions reasons

**Scope 1: Direct Emissions** – Due to the restrictive nature of our business processes, Inchmead Accountants does not generate direct emissions from owned or controlled operations, resulting in zero emissions in this category.

**Scope 2: Indirect Emissions** – Our energy usage is included within our rental agreement. However, we have requested details from the landlord regarding green energy sourcing, and this will be reflected in future iterations of our Carbon Reduction Plan (CRP).

**Scope 3 (Categories 1-4)** – Our business processes are restrictive, with no significant contributions to emissions from purchased goods, capital goods, or upstream distribution.

**Category 5: Waste** – Waste management services are provided by our landlord, and we currently lack specific data. We are working to obtain this information, which will be included in future CRP updates.

**Category 7: Employee Commuting** – At present, we do not have data on emissions from employee commuting, but we are taking steps to gather this information for future reporting.

**Categories 8-9: Upstream and Downstream Leased Assets and Distribution** – Due to the limitations of our business processes, there are no emissions contributions in these categories.

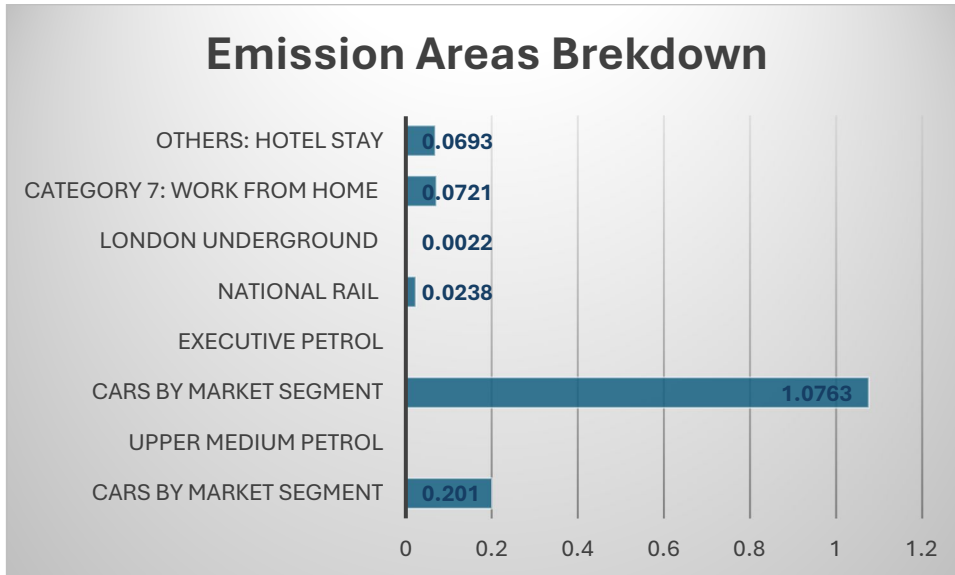

## Current Emissions Reporting 1<sup>st</sup> Aug 2023 – 31<sup>st</sup> Jul 2024

As this is the first time Inchmead Accountants is reporting its emissions in this Carbon Reduction Plan (CRP), the baseline and current emissions are the same. Our initial assessment indicates zero emissions across most categories, with limited data available for areas such as employee commuting and waste management. Moving forward, we will continue to refine our data collection and monitoring processes to provide a more comprehensive picture of our environmental impact.

## Emissions reduction targets
